- 1. Woolloomooloo Chardonnay, S.E Australia** **£18.50**
Lovely tropical fruit, green apple and melon flavours, balanced by a fresh finish.
- 2. Grand Cape Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa** **£18.95**
The sun ripened grapes of this Sauvignon from the Western Cape displays fresh, ripe tropical fruit flavours with a twist of citrus. Zippy, racy and very quaffable.
- 3. Conviviale Pinot Grigio, IGT, Italy 2016** **£19.50**
Crisp and lively dry white, lightly aromatic with characters of peach, baked apple and lemon on the nose. Medium bodied with fresh citrus acidity and underlying orchard fruit notes.
- 4. El Tesoro Verdejo, Castilla Y Leon, Spain** **£20.50**
This is delightful. Verdejo is reminiscent of a lighter style Sauvignon with balanced acidity and a fresh vibrant feel. Very perky and terrific value.

- 5. Blanco 'Rivallana', Bodegas Ondarre, Rioja, Spain** **£20.50**
Bodegas Ondarre, is based in Viana, a historic town 6 kilometres from Logroño, Rioja's capital. Founded in 1986 it has quickly become one of the standout producers in the region with its elegant and distinguishable style.
- 6. Opal Ridge Gewurztraminer Verdelho, Australia** **£20.50**
This is a delicious wine which combines the aromatic Gewurztraminer with the fuller bodied Verdelho to produce a vibrant and fresh tasting wine, medium in style.
- 7. Viognier, Tournée du Sud, Pays d'Oc, France 2015** **£21.95**
Sun-drenched peach and apricot characters, along with a merest hint of ginger, and with refreshing and sprightly acidity.
- 8. Whale Watcher, Marlborough, New Zealand 2016** **£24.95**
Lively wine bursting with gooseberry, passion fruit and thyme.
- 9. Michel Torino, Cuma Torrontes Organic** **£24.50**
If you haven't tried Torrontes before, give it a go it's a lovely fresh aromatic wine.
- 10. Picpoul de Pinet, Duc De Morny, France 2016** **£27.95**

65. **Carmel Road Pinot Noir, 2013, Monterey, California** **£42.00**
Light cherry and raspberry aromas are immediately jumping out of the glass. Juicy and smooth mouth feel, this is just delicious.
66. **Condoulet de Beaucastel** **£43.95**
Château de Beaucastel, Rhone Valley, France, 2011
A “baby Beaucastel”! From one of the great properties in Chateauneuf du Pape, this wine has a lovely palate of ripe cherries, brambles, herbs, leaves and spice. Thoroughly delicious!
67. **Château D’Angludet 2011, Margaux** **£52.00**
This property is blessed with ideal conditions for producing splendidly consistent wines. The sandy and gravelly soil provides good natural drainage, which increases concentration in the fruit. Careful selection ensures a perfect balance between fruit, structure and tannins.
68. **Château Moulinet 2009, Pomerol** **£53.95**
Classic Pomerol, enjoyed by all.
69. **Château Chasse Spleen 2006, Moulis** **£55.95**
A classic Chasse Spleen bouquet, vibrant and full of black fruits with a little leather Dshowing. The palate is lively and a little rumbustious. Avery well made wine.
70. **Domaine Drouhin Pinot Noir, Cuvee Laurene 2009** **£59.00**
Internationally known for their pure expression of fruit, superior balance, silky texture and classical elegance.
71. **Château Bellegrave 2009, Pomerol** **£57.95**
With a classic 'left bank' nose of smoky blackberry fruit and pencil lead, the palate is rich and rounded with assertive tannins, ample fruit and well integrated oak.
72. **Clarendon Hills, Hickenbotham Syrah 2001** **£59.95**
South Australia
Simply outstanding, this will not disappoint.
73. **Château Batailley 2008 AC Pauillac, France** **£69.95**
Nicely structured, classic Pauillac style, with hints of tobacco.
74. **Château Smith Haut Lafitte, Pessac-Leognan, France** **£225.00**
The finest wine ever made by proprietors Daniel and Florence Cathiard, the 2009 Smith-Haut-Lafitte exhibits an opaque blue/purple colour in addition to a glorious nose of acacia flowers, licorice, charcoal, blueberries, black raspberries, lead pencil shavings and incense. This massive, extraordinarily rich, unctuously textured wine may be the most concentrated effort produced to date, although the 2000, 2005 and 2010 are nearly as prodigious. A gorgeous expression of Pessac-Leognan with sweet tannin, emerging charm and delicacy, and considerable power, depth, richness and authority, it should age effortlessly for 30-40+ years. Bravo!
